Make a Plan...

With the recent earthquakes it certainly makes you think about making an emergency plan. Here are a few tips from Civil Defence 'Never Happens? Happens brochure.

- If we can't get home Where will we meet if we can't get home (local and out of town?) Who picks up the kids if we can't?
- If we can't get hold of each other Who will we check in with (someone out of town in case local phone lines are down)? How will we find the latest news/alerts (which radio stations, websites, and social media page)? Eg Brian FM Whanganui 91.2 FM
- Who might need our help? Neighbours, family others.
- If we are stuck at home Do we have emergency supplies? Food and drink for three days or more (for everyone including babies and pets)? Torches and radio with batteries? First aid/medical supplies? They don't all need to be in one big box, but you may have to find them in the dark. Do we know how to turn off water, power gas?
- If we have no water Do we have enough stored drinking water 3 litres per person per day for 3 days or more, and changed every 6 months).
